Qualifications and Competencies

- ❖ Shall be an officer in Special Grade of Sri Lanka Administrative Service with a Post Graduate Degree relevant to the scopes of Sri Lanka Institute of Development Administration and have completed 20 years of service in Executive/ Manager posts and possessed five (05) years of experience out of the said period in the Senior Manager level.

or

- ❖ Shall have obtained a Post Graduate Degree relevant to the scopes of Sri Lanka Institute of Development Administration recognized by the University Grants Commission.

and

Shall have possessed experience of 20 years as an officer at Senior Manager Executive level and served as an Additional Director General for three (03) years out of the said period.

or

- ❖ Shall have completed a service of 20 years in Executive/ Manager Posts in Public Service or in a Statutory Board with a Post Graduate Degree relevant to the scopes of Sri Lanka Institute of Development Administration recognized by University Grants Commission and possessed experience of five (05) years out of the said period at the Senior Manager level (HM 2-1).
- ❖ Shall be not less than 35 years and not more than 55 years of age. The maximum age limit shall not be applicable to internal applicants and Public Officers.
