*Payment of Extra Remuneration to State Officers
released to Statutory Boards and Corporations*

1. Reference is requested to Treasury Circular Letter No. Establishments 95 of 14.10.69 on the subject of the "33 1/3 % Limit on Extra Remuneration".
2. Government has made the following decisions on the remuneration to be paid to State Officers released temporarily to Statutory Boards and Corporations.
 - 2: 1 the remuneration paid to State Officers temporarily released for service in Statutory Boards and Corporations should be in accordance with the acting pay rules applicable to State Officers acting in posts in the State Service, as laid down in Section 12 of Chapter VII of the Establishments Code; and
 - 2: 2 State Officers already on release to Statutory Boards and Corporations will continue to be remunerated as at present until their period of release expires.
3. It should be noted that the period of release of any State Officer to a Corporation is limited to two years.
4. The Treasury Circular Letter referred to in para. 1 is hereby cancelled.
5. Secretaries are requested to bring these decisions to the notice of all Statutory Boards and Corporations (including the Central Bank, the Bank of Ceylon, the People's Bank, the National Savings Bank and the Universities) for their compliance.
