## Maintenance of Buildings.

The standard of maintenance of government and other buildings occupied by Government and Statutory Bolies has deteriorated a great deal. As these buildings are located centrally in Colombo as well as in the outstations, the condition of neglect of these buildings mays the scenic beauty of the landscape.

2. Government has therefore decided that buildings occupied by Departments and Statutory Bodies should be colour-washed and essential repairs effected and maintained in a good state of repair. All Peads of Departments and Statutory Bodies should if funds are not already available, seek provisions from their respective Ministries for this purpose.

J. Dyen where buildings are satisfactorily maistained it is often found that lawns and gardens are neglected and surgests with woods. By contrast, most private firms keep their lawns and gardens in good condition thus making the epithonoment look pleasant and attractive. Since Public Sector Establishments have provision for garden labourers a special erfort should be made to ensure that flower-beds and lawns are maintained well and flowering shreps planted along boundaries and in empty speces so as to add to the bedstyres that environment.

4. Sucretarios to Ministrica are kniedly requested to ensure that these instructions are followed by all Departments and statutory Endies under their supervision. Astin on this directar should be reviewed from time to time and serious notices taken in cases where buildings continue to show an air of neglect and Inwas and gardens continue to remain preference with weeds and rank registrious.
