To: All Secretaries to Ministries
and Heads of Departments.

Medical Examinations - Chapter XXVI of
the Establishments Code.

Please delete sub-section 4:2 of Chapter XXVI of the
Establishments Code and substitute the following therefor:-

" 4:2-For this purpose an application on form
G.142, should be made to the Director of
the General Hospital(Teaching) Colombo,
Kandy, Peradeniya, Galle or Jaffna in respect
of an officer working in the respective
district. In all other instances application
should be made to the Regional Director of
Health Services of the area.

The Director of the General Hospital(Teaching)/
the Regional Director of Health Services will
arrange for a Medical Examination Board.

If no Medical Examination Boards are held in
the region concerned, the officer will be
referred to the Regional Director of Health
Services of the adjoining or nearest region
where a Board could be constituted. No Medical
Officer who issues the Medical Certificates
should function as a Member of the Board to
examine the same patient."
