Payment of increment to a public officer  
retiring on reaching 60 years of age.

A public officer retiring from service on reaching 60 years of age and had not reached the maximum salary step of his scale should be allowed to add his earned increment (the proportion of increment due from the date of last increment to the day prior to the date of retirement) to his last drawn salary for purposes of calculation of pension provided his work, conduct and attendance have been satisfactory.
