Your attention is hereby drawn to Sub Section 3, Chapter XLVII, Volume II of Establishments

Code.

02. In terms of the provisions of the aforesaid Section, receiving of any presents, gifts or

other benefits by an officer in public service, whether in a direct or indirect form shall be an

offence fallen under Schedule One of the Establishments Code and further it has been stated that

such act shall be a criminal offence for which a punishment of 07 years imprisonment and a fine

up to Rs. 5000/- can be imposed under Section 19 (C) of the Bribery Act.

03. There may be instances where the gift parcels, gift vouchers, air tickets, prepaid

accommodation facilities at hotels, etc are offered to public officers by the private companies

during the festival seasons. Therefore, it is hereby emphasized to inform all the officers in your

institution to refrain from receiving such gifts.
