01. Local Development Support Project (LDSP)

LDSP is funded by a loan from the World Bank (WB) and a grant from the European Union with the financial assistance of Government of Sri Lanka (GOSL). The Project development objective is “to strengthen Local Government Authorities’ capabilities to deliver services to communities in a responsive and accountable manner and to support economic infrastructure development in participating provinces, and to provide immediate and effective response to an eligible crisis or health emergency”. The total estimated cost of the project is **US\$. 100.84Mn**. The duration of the project is 2019.06.30 to 2023.07.31. All 134 Local Authorities in Northern, Eastern, North Central & Uva Provinces are covered by the project.

A Project Coordinating Unit (PCU) has been established in the Ministry of Public Administration, Home Affairs, Provincial Councils & Local Government, (No: 330, Union Place, Colombo -02) and 4 Project Implementation Units (PIUs) are established in Northern, Eastern, North Central and Uva Provinces.

- I. A successfully completed Bachelor’s Degree in the relevant field, which is recognized by the University Grants Commission.

A qualification recognized by the University Grants Commission as an equivalent qualification to the degree in the relevant field.

An Associate membership/ A similar professional qualification obtained from a recognized professional institution in the relevant field.

At least 08 years post qualifying experience in the relevant field.

- II. An officer of the Government All Island Services Class III/II or above or similar status in the relevant field.

At least 08 years of experience in Class III/II post.

- Preference will be given to the applicant who has experience in foreign funded projects.
- **Method of selection:** shortlisted applications based on qualifications and experience will be called for an Interview.
- **Age:** Below 60 years as at the date of closing of application.
- **Terms of Employment:** All appointments will be on acting basis while serving in his/her substantive post up to 2023.07.31 and extendable based on the project extension and satisfactory performances.
